It is a series of event : inviting 6 architects from France and Japan to conduct two type of talk session for 3 days intensively.

'ARCHITECTURE' \Rightarrow 'KENCHIKU', the word delivers from Europe and translated into Japanese, however it developed separately with different background and urban condition. Under the theme, 'HOW AND WHERE TO APPLY ARCHITECTURAL THINKING?', this project examines gap between 'ARCHITECTURE' and KENCHIKU' from the aspect of contemporary architectural scene and evoke possible creative collaboration of 'KENCHIKU ARCHITECTURE' ahead.
